him.

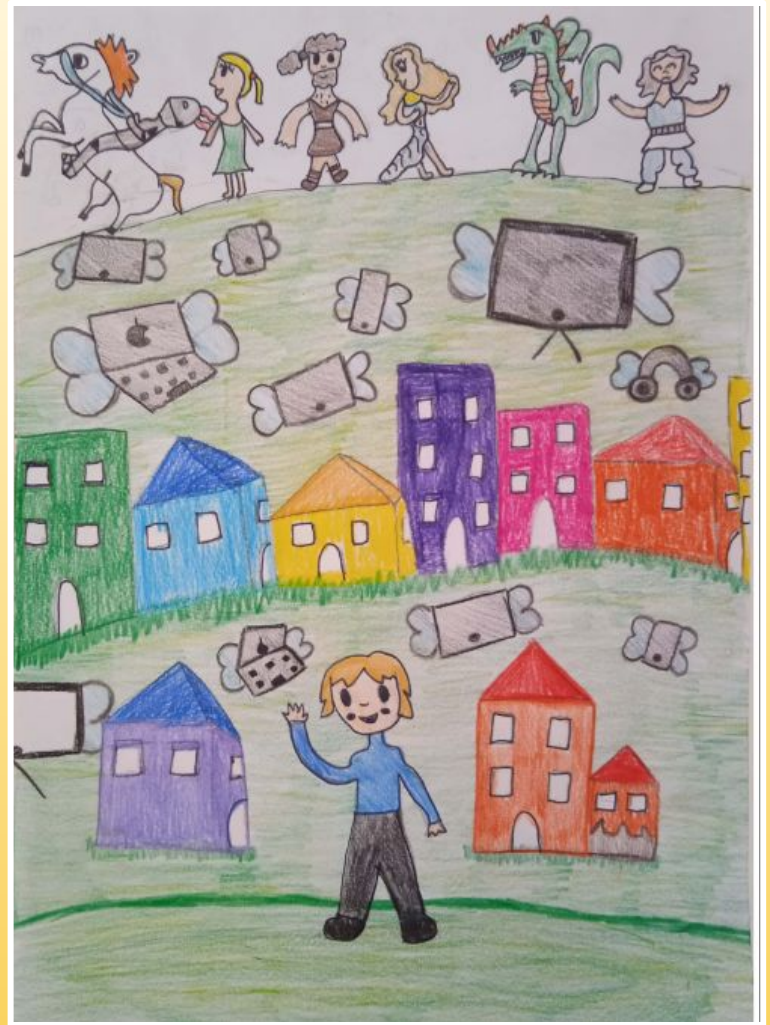


Dante leaves his home and he goes to his grandad's, his safe haven.

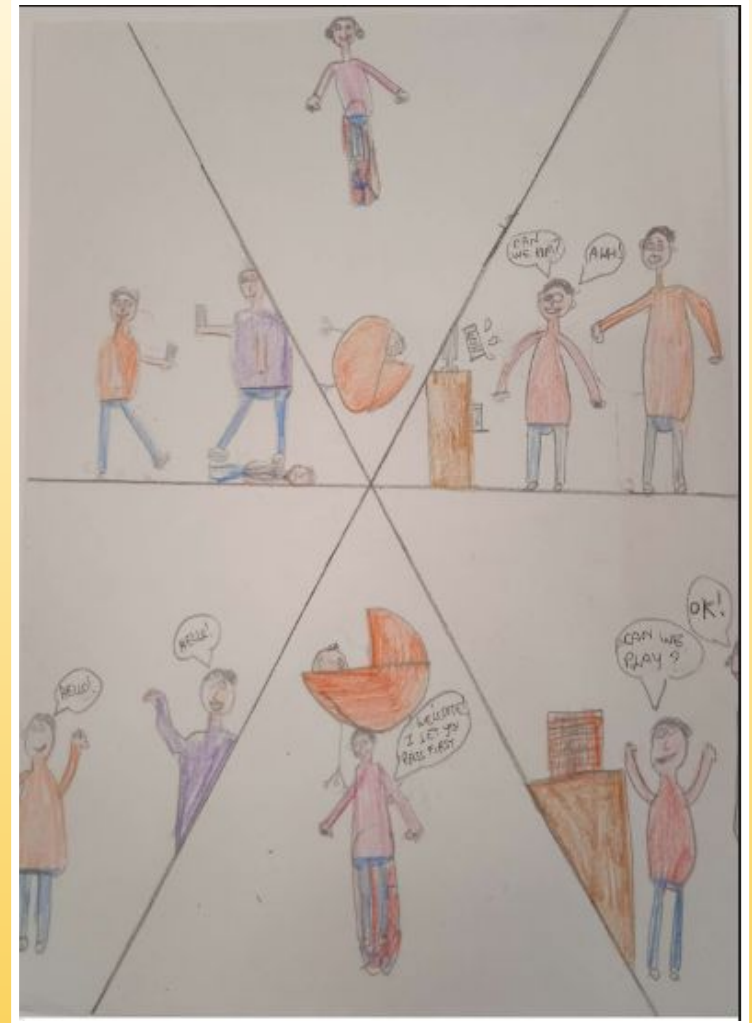
He tells him what happened that day and asks for help.

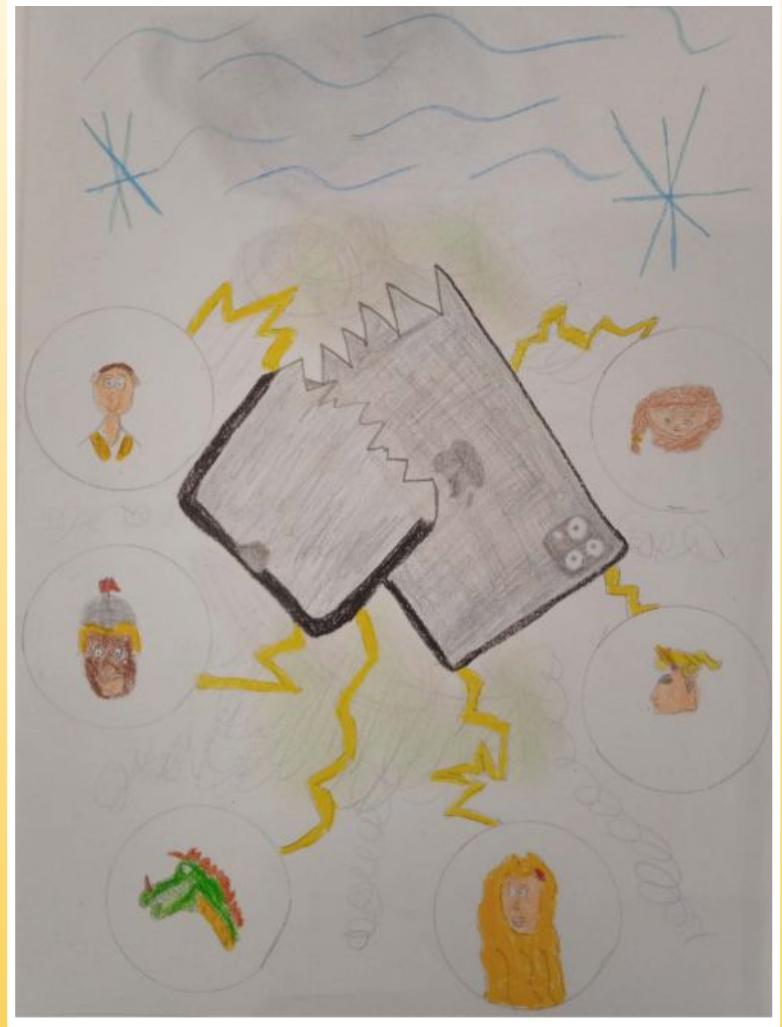
